



PAYMENT OF FEES:

A non-refundable Application Fee is required to process your child's application before an admissions test. Payment is due and payable thirty (30) days from the invoice issue date. Fees unpaid by the due date on the invoice may be subjected to late fee charge of 5%. A student may not start the new term unless the first term fees have been paid in full. The School reserves the right to refuse a student entry to class in the event of non-payment of fees. Re-registration will not be accepted unless all fees have been paid in full

WITHDRAWAL POLICY:

All withdrawals are subject to an Administrative Charge of RM350. A Withdrawal Notification Form must be completed and submitted to the Administration Office for acknowledgement; marked for the attention of the Principal. If requesting a refund of fees, it must be indicated on the Withdrawal Notification Form at the time of submission. The refund policy will be as directed by the School Board. Parents who are withdrawing their child from the School completely are required to give, in writing i.e. complete and submit the Withdrawal Notification Form, at least one full academic term's notice. This should be done on or before the first day of the same academic term. Failing which (where less than one term's notice of withdrawal is given,) a minimum charge of one term's tuition fee will be imposed. All tuition fees paid are nonrefundable once the term starts.
