## **SECONDARY**

## **LOWER SECONDARY SCHOOL (AGE 11-14)**

The school follows the National Curriculum for England appropriately modified for international students. This modified national curriculum provides pupils with an introduction to the essential knowledge that they need to be educated citizens. It introduces pupils to the best that has been thought and said; and helps engender an appreciation of human creativity and achievement. There is also time and space in the school day and in each week, term and year to range beyond the curriculum specifications into areas such as community learning and global citizenship. The modified national curriculum of England provides an outline of core knowledge around which teachers can develop exciting and stimulating lessons to promote the development of pupils' knowledge, understanding and skills as part of the wider school curriculum.

## **UPPER SECONDARY SCHOOL (AGE 15-16)**

In Years 10 and 11, students will choose from a range of subjects leading to the Cambridge IGCSE examinations. The Cambridge IGCSE curriculum offers a variety of routes for learners with a wide range of abilities, including those whose first language is not English. This curriculum allows teachers to add breadth and cross-curricular perspectives. Encouraging learners to engage with a variety of subjects, and make connections between them, is fundamental to the approach of the Cambridge IGCSE curriculum. For schools, Cambridge IGCSE offers a flexible and stimulating curriculum, supported with excellent resources and training. For learners, Cambridge IGCSE helps to improve performance by developing skills in creative thinking, enquiry and problem solving. It is the perfect springboard to advanced study.

Sign and return the acceptance form together with the registration and deposit payment for your child to be enrolled.



### When should I apply?

We do enroll our students on interim basis. However, we would recommend you to apply as early as possible to secure the place for your child.

How does the school determine what year group my child will be placed in? Students are enrolled according to their year of birth.

### What is the House System?

Every student is assigned to one of four Houses within the school. These Houses provide smaller communities within the school, allowing students to identify the staff and fellow students outside their own year group and beyond International and National Schools, while giving them a focus of identity beyond their year and tutor groups. Healthy competition is also established between Houses through school sports, arts and academic competitions.

### What does the school do to help children develop their English?

Students who may need support in English Learning are assessed by the English as an Additional Language (EAL) teacher. This assessment is then used to inform areas of strength and weakness and these are then addressed though extra in class support such as differentiated tasks, bilingual dictionaries, visual prompts and writing frames and also through specialist withdrawn lessons taught by our dedicated EAL teacher. In Tenby International Secondary School, new students are assessed in terms of their English language level and reading age. Once the results have been established, the English department can determine which class would be most suitable for the student based on their understanding and knowledge of the subject. Depending on the year group, this could also determine the examinations the student would take. The English teachers also aim to personalise the student's learning and adapt teaching methods to meet the needs of the individual student and the class as a whole.
