Q: When is the school opening?

A: For the 2020 / 2021 academic year, UIS KL will commence classes on 4th January 2021. For the following year, classes will commence in September following the common international school calendar.

Q: What is the ratio of expatriate and local teachers at UIS KL?

A: 70% of our teachers are expatriates, and 30% will be local teachers.

Q: Where can we access the profile of the school's teachers?

A: The profile, qualifications, and experiences of the teachers are uploaded in our website. You may read about our teachers here: bit.ly/UISKLMeetOurTeacher

Q: My child is currently studying in another international school and the first term is from September to December 2020. Are they still eligible to join UIS KL this academic year?

A: Yes, we are happy to welcome your child to UIS KL! Your child will still be eligible to join our school in January 2021.



Q: Will students be required to bring their own laptop or tablet to school?

A: As a school supported by Apple Education, students from Year 4-11 will be required to bring along an iPad. For Year 1-3 students, iPads will be provided by the school and shared among the students.

Q: Can we purchase the iPad from the school? Can my child use our existing iPad to school?

A: Yes, you may purchase the iPad (8th Gen) directly from us for RM1,750. A student could use their own iPad if it is the same spec or above as the one we require students to have. The iPad will need to come under the UCSI Apple school management and this may remove existing apps and stored work.

Q: To what extend will technology be integrated into the curriculum? Will textbooks still be used in school?

A: Yes, textbooks will be used in school. A full book list will be published closer to school starting. Technology is an important focus of our school and there will be IT/coding/design classes for all students. Throughout the curriculum technology will be used to enhance learning in the classroom and will only be used when appropriate to the activity.



Q: What will be the school hours?

A: The school hours for Primary Years will be from 7.50am – 3.00pm, while Secondary Years will be 7.45am-3.25pm. CCA will be held from 3.30pm-4.30pm.

Q: Does the school provide transportation for students?

A: Yes, we have a list of bus and van transporters who can arrange transport to school. You may refer to our transport list here: http://bit.ly/UCSISchoolsTransport

Q: How often are Co-curriculum activities (CCA) held per week?

A: CCA will be held 3 times per week, on Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday, from 3.30pm-4.30pm.

Q: Is lunch provided at the school?

A: Meal Plans are available for Year 1-3 students. Students of Year 4-11 will be able to purchase food directly from the cafeteria through a cashless system. However during RMCO only Meal Plans are provided based on MOE's guidelines.



Q: Since the first school academic year is shortened for Year 1-9, would the school be able to cover the curriculum?

A: Yes we can. Our teachers will be working closely with the students to ensure that all curriculum will be covered within the academic year.

Q: How many terms are offered in the first year of school establishment?

A: For the first academic year, 2 extended terms are offered. Tuition fees and tech fees are made in 3 payments by 1 January, 1 April and 1 June.

Q: Will Muslim students be given time off to attend Friday prayers?

A: Yes of course. Muslim students can leave on a Friday to attend prayers, it would be great if they were able to return afterwards for the remaining lessons. Parents/ guardians will be required to collect students from the school reception.





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
